- Gator Assistance Programs are awarded on a first come first serve basis. Awards are dependent upon the availability of funds.
- Daycare Reimbursements are direct deposited to the student after the "Certification of Services Rendered" document has been submitted each month.
- Certification of Services Rendered must be submitted by the due date. Due dates are provided upon approval for the Gator Assistance Program. Failure to turn in the Certification of Services Rendered by the due date will forfeit payment for that month. If two payments have been forfeited, student will not be eligible for GAP in the following semester.
- The student is responsible for paying their daycare fees as they are due. GAP is a reimbursement.
- GAP does not pay for childcare on school holidays. As long as the child attends one day out of the week, the weekly allotted amount is paid.
- Up to three dependents (Infants through 12 years of age) can be covered by GAP.
- The amount of assistance to be provided is as follows:

Infants - Age 1 - \$60 per week Age 2 - Age 6 - \$50 per week Age 7 - Age 12 - \$40 per week

• Students have the right to choose an individual to provide their childcare or a licensed daycare facility.
