NCLB Highly Qualified Compliance

You will not be considered by a school district for employment unless you meet the "highly qualified" requirement.

Certification Area	Criteria to be considered "highly qualified"
Generalist EC-4	Pass the content TExES test
Grades 4-8 Core Subjects	--If teaching grades 4 th , 5 th or 6 th you must pass the content exam in the subject. --If teaching grades 7 th or 8 th you must have 24 hours in the subject (with 12 hrs upper level) OR have an academic major in the subject OR pass the content test
Grades 7-12 Core Subjects	--Pass the content TExES test --Have an academic major in subject --Have 24 hours in the subject with 12 hrs being upper level
Special Education EC-12	--Passing the content test gives "highly qualified" status for teaching English Language Arts or Math up to 8 th grade --You must take subject test to have "highly qualified" status for other subjects

Field-Based Experience

In order to enroll in field based experience:

- Must be Teacher of Record employed by a school district
- Must be mentored by ACE Program for one full school year (2 sem)
