Early College High School: (Variable name: ECHS_FLAG) Colleges that have dually-enrolled students enrolled in an early college high school (ECHS) were offered the opportunity to provide the list of the ECHS name. The CCCSE research team used this list to flag students attending these institutions as attending an ECHS.
