- Register yourself for classes through Student Services. Refer to the course recommendation sheet or DegreeWorks planner from your advisor.

### **Students with Disabilities**

- ☐ If you are a student with a disability, you must meet with the Disability Support Services (DSS) coordinator in the Advising Office to request assistance and receive accommodations.
- You must provide documented support of your disability in the form of high school records (i.e., senior level ARD and FIE), current psychological evaluation or medical records signed by an appropriate professional, and meet set criteria.
